

Drug Checking in Interior Health

This report summarizes key indicators for Fourier Transform Infrared (FT-IR)/fentanyl test strip combination drug checking done in Interior Health in September 2019.

As the FT-IR spectrometer has a detection limit of 3-4% by weight (Sherman et al., 2018), unless otherwise stated, a drug check on any given sample consists of **both** Bruker

lysergic acid diethylamide (LSD) immunoassay test strips are also used. Please note that these data are not finalized and are subject to change.

ALPHA Fourier-Transform Infrared (FTIR) spectrometer and BTNX fentanyl immunoassay test strip testing done in combination. When applicable, BTNX benzodiazepine or





Psychedelic may include: 2C-family, tryptamines,

ketamine, MDMA, LSD, cannabis

Stimulant may include: "speed", crystal meth,

Unknown includes: all samples in which the cocaine, cathinones client could not identify the expected substance
